

## **General Rules and Regulations of the Salt Lake County Equestrian Park and Events Center\***

### **Alcohol**

Beer and/or alcohol is not permitted in the park except in the arena when sold by Equestrian Park staff or contracted providers. Failure to abide by this rule may result in removal from the park and action by local law enforcement.

### **Smoking in the Park**

No smoking in the park as per SLCO Ordinance – title 13, Section 13.04 285 & 286, except in the parking lots

No smoking inside any structures including but not limited to barns, indoor arena, crows nests, offices, tack rooms, etc.

### **Dogs in the Park**

Dogs are permitted in designated areas. They are not permitted to be on the concourse at any time. Dogs are not allowed to run with horses, leashed or unleashed, while in arenas. Owners must leash their dogs. Owners must clean up after their dogs. Owners must accompany their dogs at all times. Owners are solely responsible for any damage or injury caused by their dogs.

### **Theft**

Stealing, which include but is not limited to taking shavings, taking hay or other items for usage, stealing tack, as well as theft of services for not paying riding fees is strictly prohibited. County Policy is that those caught stealing will be evicted and trespassed from the park and we will prosecute those whom steal to the full extent of the law. We encourage boarders to do likewise.

### **No Littering, use black cans**

No manure in black cans, please use manure bins. Blue cans are for recyclables

### **No Overnight camping/Fires**

Overnight camping in an RV is only permitted with written permission from the Salt Lake County Equestrian Park Manager

### **No Golfing**

### **No Firearms/Archery**

### **No amplified sound in the barns.**

Arena sound is permitted with permission of Salt Lake County Equestrian Park Management

### **Children in the park**

In the "Boarding and stall Rental/Permit Agreement" that you all signed it states clearly that you are responsible for all people you invite in the park and for the damage they do in the park. We will hold you accountable for invitees and children you bring into the park and the damage they do.

10. *DAMAGES TO PROPERTY:*

*PERMITTEE will supervise and control all children or invitees that PERMITTEE brings to the PARK. PERMITTEE shall be responsible for all damages to COUNTY property resulting from PERMITTEE's personal use or damage caused by his/her animal(s), employees, agents, family or invitees.*

We ask that you use common sense when you bring children and other people to the park. We ask that you supervise your children and guests so that they are not:

1. Touching horses that do not belong to you
2. Within three feet of the front of any stall (Patrons are allowed to place things three feet in front of their stalls)
3. Touching or playing with things that are not yours
4. Playing on, with or around any structures, stalls, bins, gates, etc.
5. Opening gates or stalls that are not yours
6. Out of your sight

And please inform all of your guests of our park rules so that they can be conscious and courteous of all who use our park.
