

# Salt Lake County Equestrian Park Policy on

## Riding Passes

Thank you for purchasing a riding pass. We are excited that you chose our facility and want to ensure that you have a great time using the park. Here are a few reminders about the riding pass you just purchased. We ask that you follow these rules so that we can all enjoy riding our horses and using the park. Thank You!

1. Riding passes are sold PER HORSE – you must have a riding pass for EVERY horse that you bring into the park
2. Riding passes must be visible on the horse while riding in the arena
3. No barrels, poles, lounging or any other activity that requires a large amount of space is permitted during open ride
4. You are responsible for your animals and any damage or injury caused by your animals while it is in the park
5. Please do not tie your horses to any green panels within the park. You may tie them to the white railing inside the indoor arena or your trailer outside.
6. The Indoor arena will be worked twice a day (refer to the monthly schedule available in the office). Once in the morning and once in the evening. NO horses will be allowed inside the arena while the arena is being worked
7. Please observe all park policies and rules while using the park (all policies are available in the office)
8. SLCO ORDINANCE – TITLE 13, SECTION 13.04 285 & 286 prohibit smoking within the park, excluding the parking lot
9. DOGS must be on a leash within the park and cannot be in the indoor arena (SLCO ORDINANCE – TITLE 13, SECTION 13.04 100 & 300)
10. NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL or BEER is permitted inside the park at anytime
